

## Nativity House Community Supported Agriculture Working Member Agreement 2022

This describes the CSA working membership. Please fill this out and bring the contribution to your first work day.

**Cost:** A full working membership includes a weekly share of produce, weekly 1 pt of goat milk, and 1 qt of honey in the spring or fall and will contribute \$350. The ½ working membership includes a weekly ½ share of produce and 1 qt of honey in the fall and will contribute \$250. Your contributions are used for the purchase of needed seed, soil amendments, organic fertilizers, equipment maintenance, tool replacement, and any other materials for the 2022 growing season.

## **Schedule**

- Info/Planning Coffee: Saturday, February 12, 10-11am.
- Spring Prep Days: Saturdays, March 26, April 9, 23, 30; 9am-11am; 3 out of the 4 are required.
- May Plantings: Weekly work commitment begins May, each Saturday from 9-11 am.
- **Summer Cultivation: June-August:** Each working membership is required to work on day each week: Either the Thursday, 6–8 am, or Saturday, 9–11 am.
- Harvest: September-October: All work days will be on Saturdays 9–11 am.
- **Turn Over: November:** Garden clean up will be Saturday, October 29, 9–11am. The rain date is Saturday, November 5. All members attend.

Our success depends on all members giving a solid 2 hours of work. Each working membership must provide at least one working adult for the entire 2 hours. Please text or email an RSVP each week so we have head counts and can plan the activities appropriately. Bring sun protection, a water bottle, and gloves.

Substitutes: If a member must miss a day every effort should be made to get a substitute; send a friend!

**Shares:** Each membership will receive a share of the produce each work day. Produce is divided equally among members each work day. Please bring a good bag as needed.
